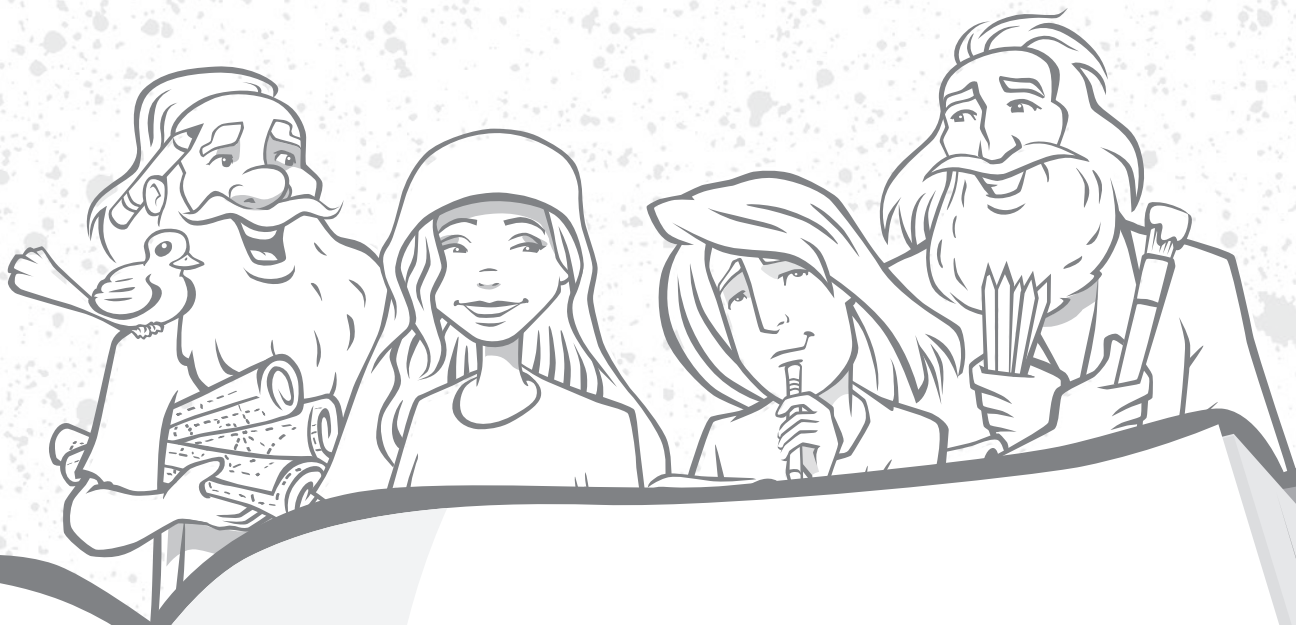

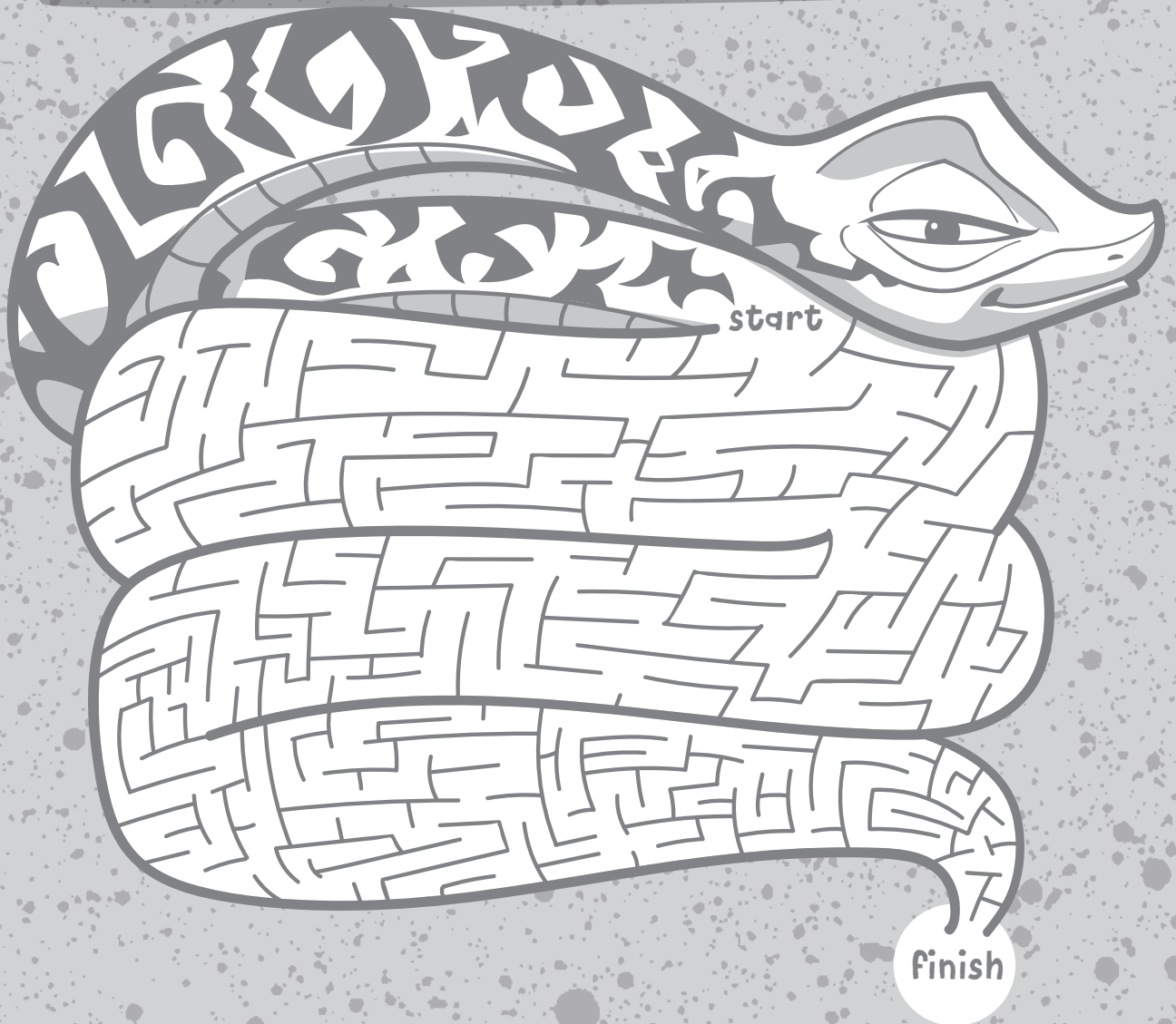

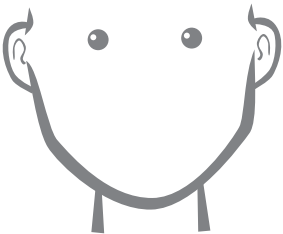
That's Not Funny

I did some **BAD THINGS** to my brother. I lied, I cheated, and I tricked him. My name, Jacob, means "supplanter,"

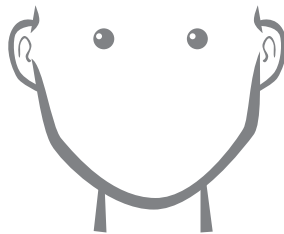
which is another way of saying "undermine" or "replace." (Those aren't good things.)

Thankfully, **GOD CHANGED MY NAME** to Israel, which means "God wins." I like that better!

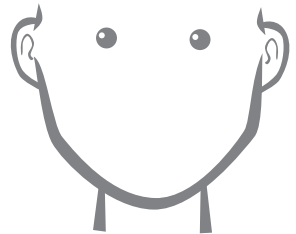
