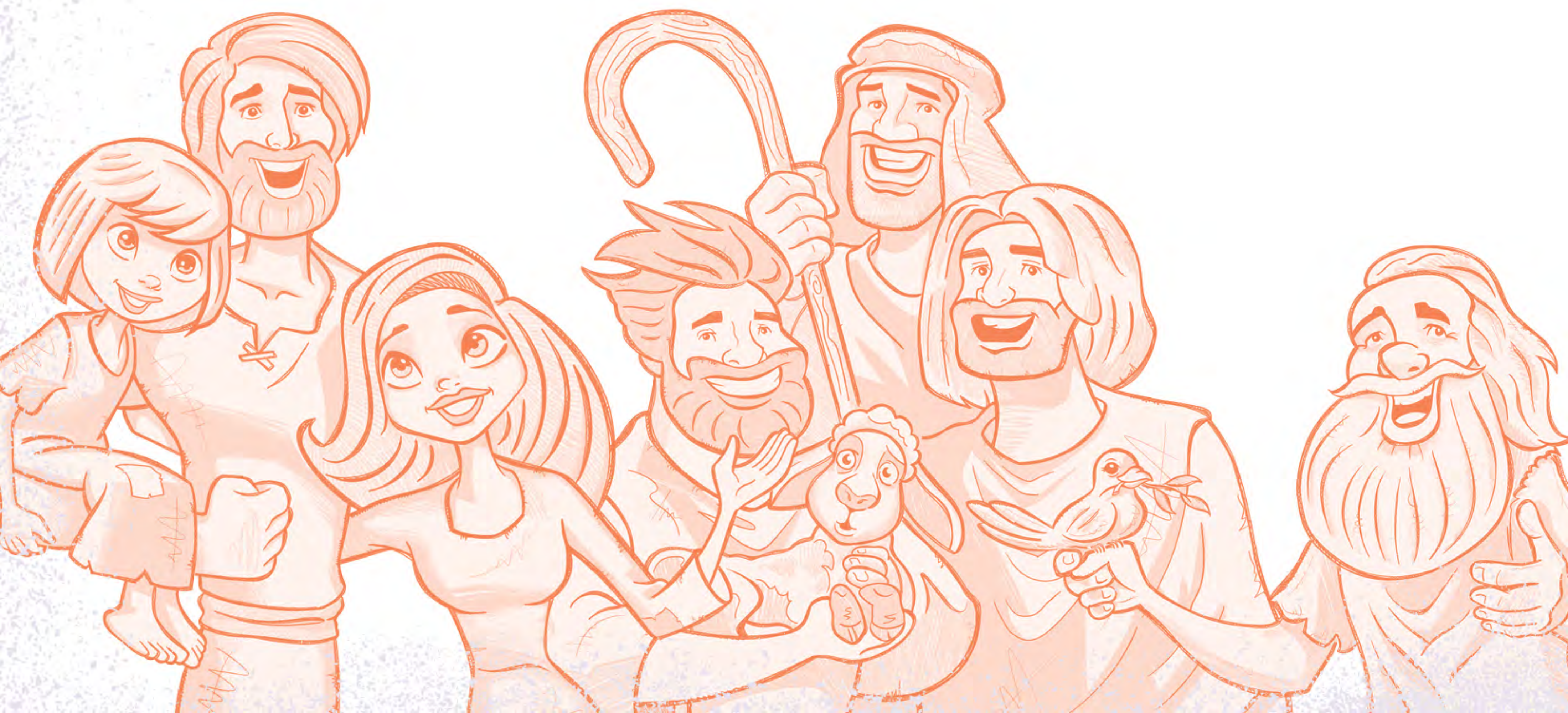

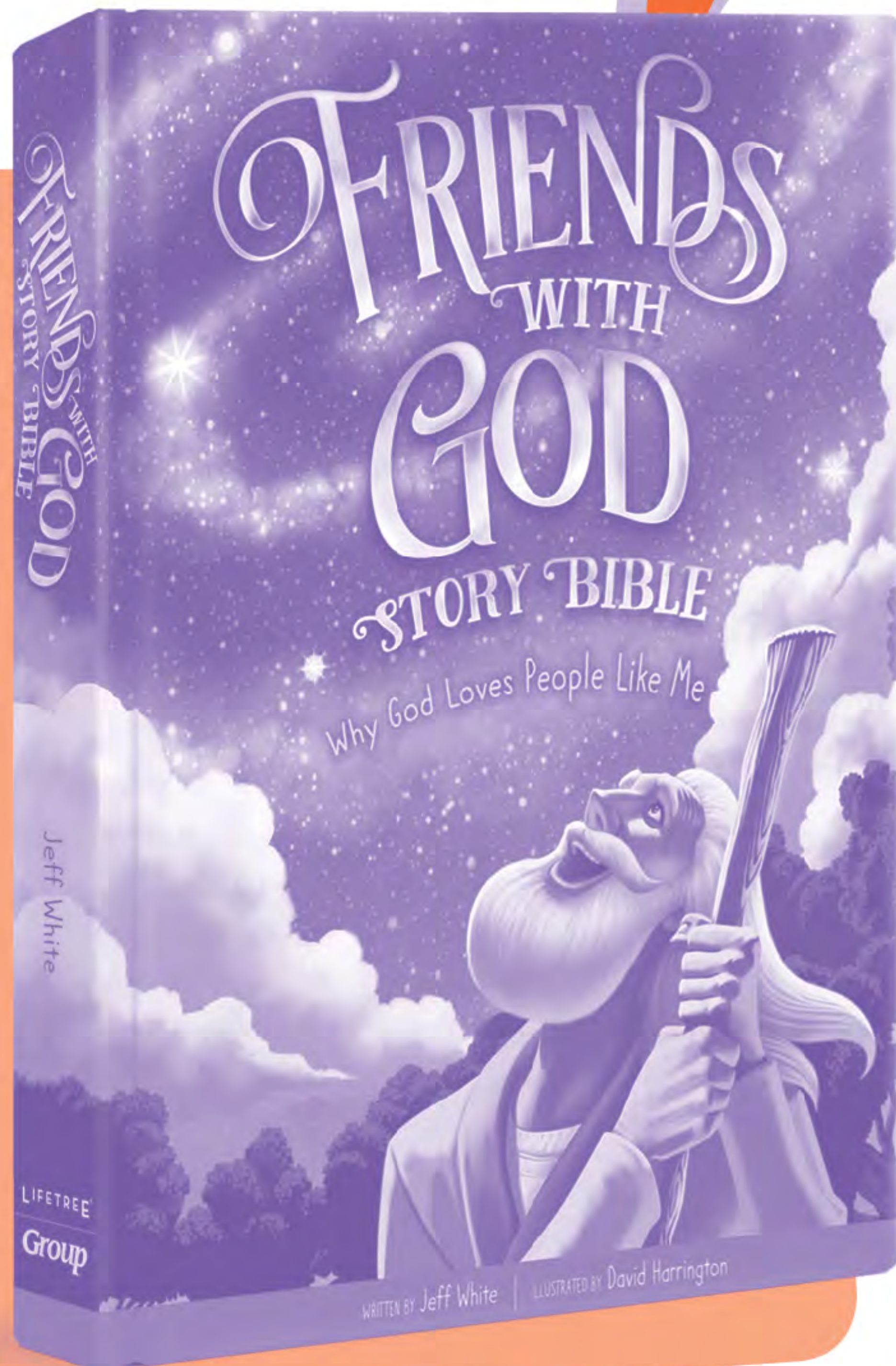
YOU ARE GOD'S FRIEND

And this faith journal helps you explore *your* friendship with God.



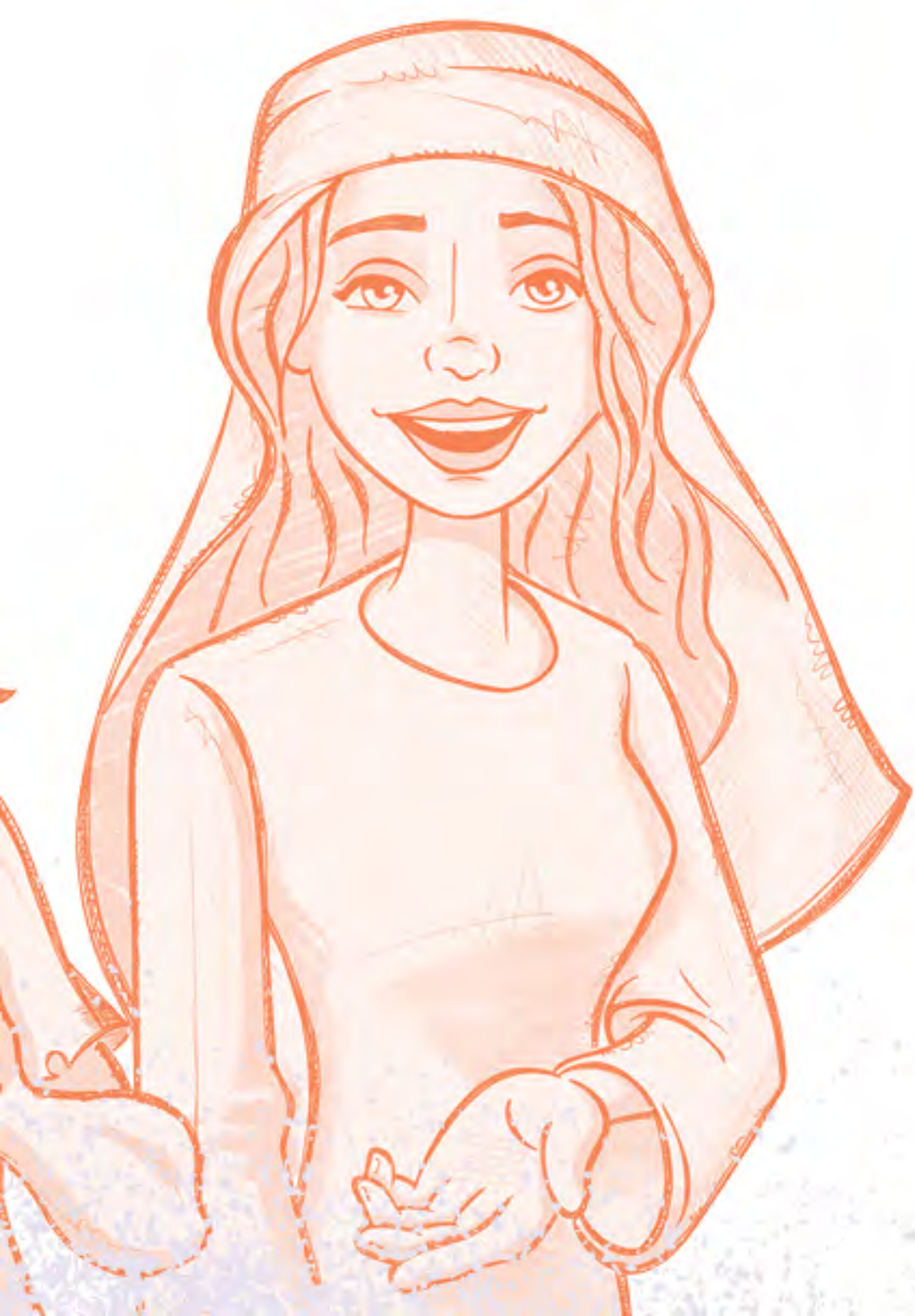
Read the *Friends With God Story Bible*!

We're Adam and Eve. We were the first people God created. And God made us perfect. Aren't we a cute couple?

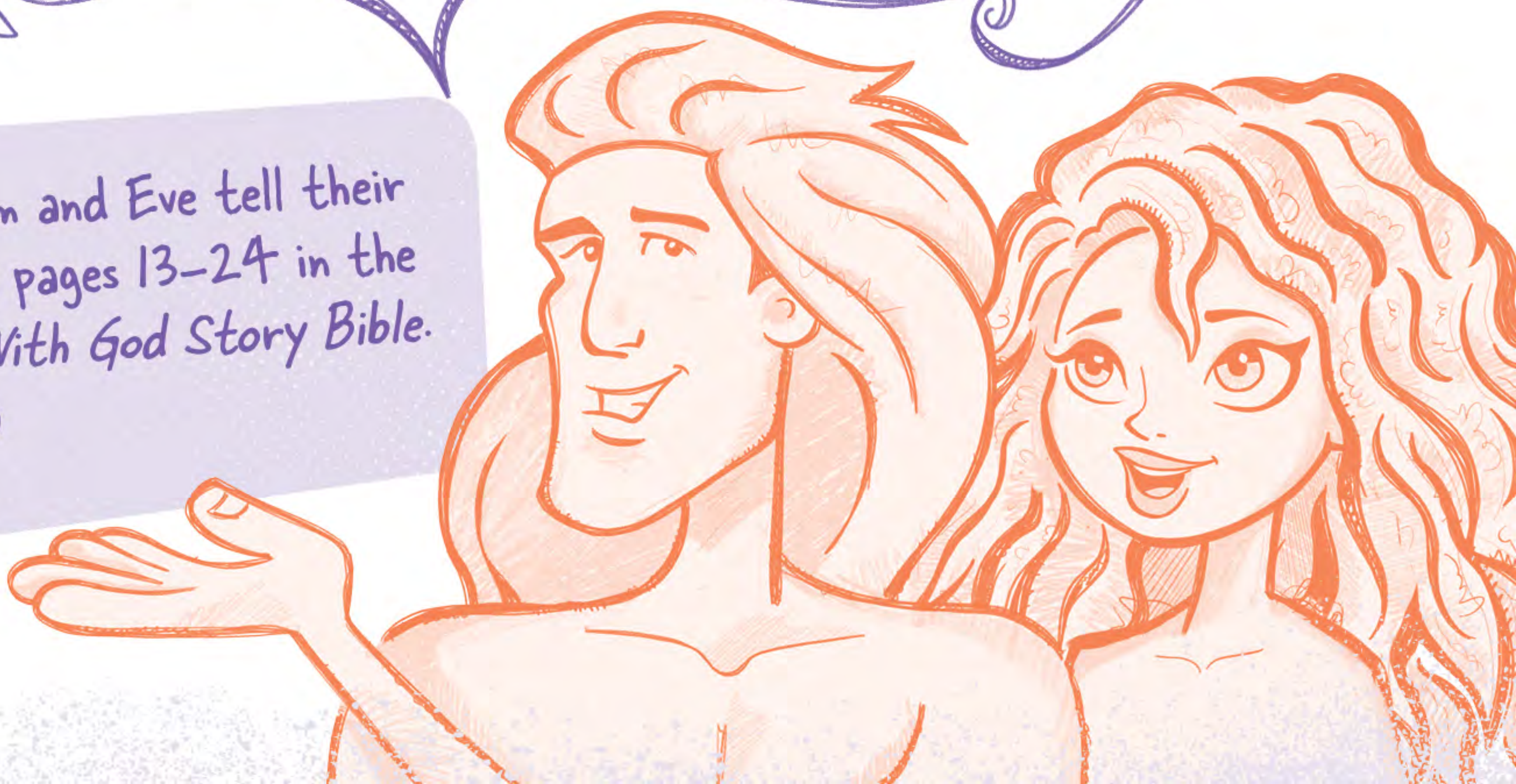

You are God's friend, too. And, like a loyal, loving friend, God will always stick with you. He does that because of his grace, which is a word that means being given something good even though you don't deserve it.

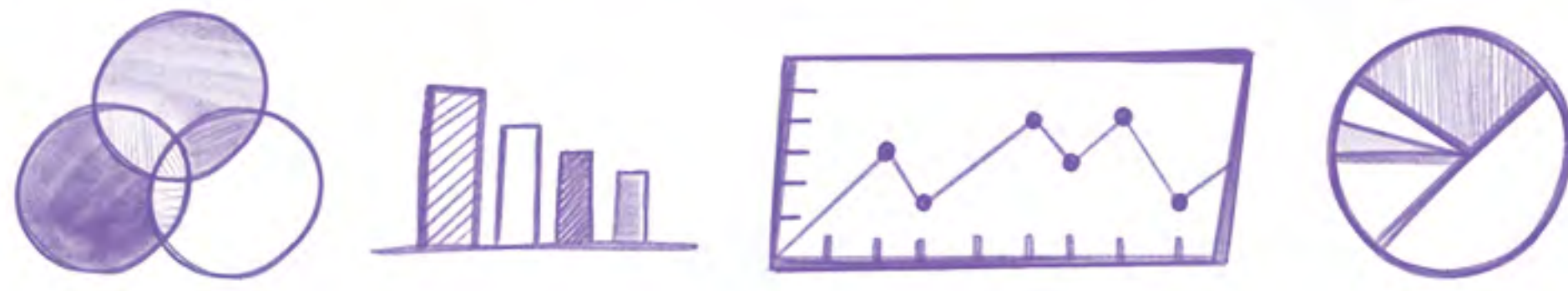
God loves you and helps you, even when you mess up. God is the kind of friend who lets you try again when you fail. God never gives up on you!



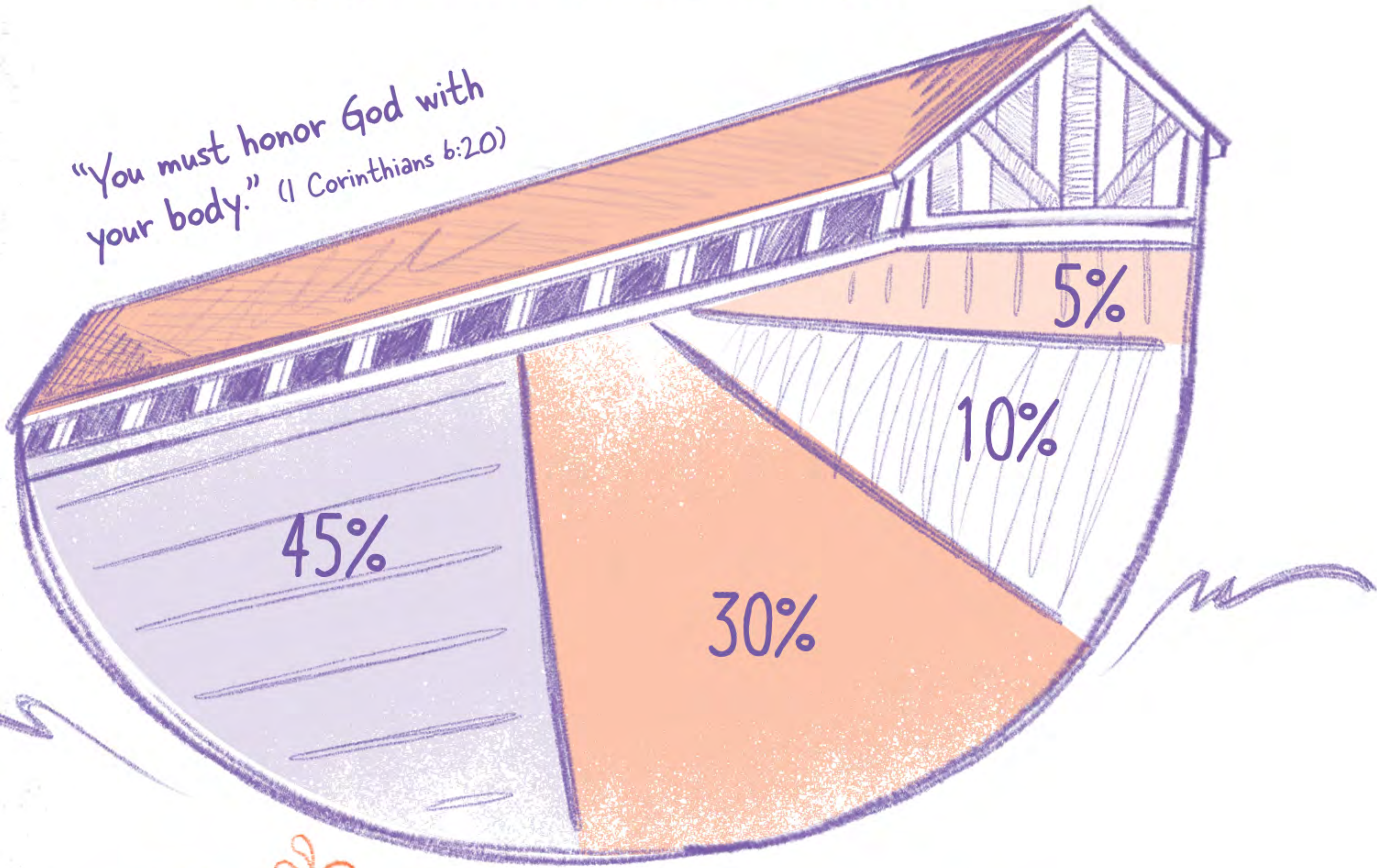
